

Cafeteria Volunteer Workers

The Cafeteria is staffed by a Manager and volunteers from St. Anthony's Grade School and Parish Family. On a daily basis it takes the manager and a staff of at least 7 volunteers to assure that things move as quickly and smoothly as possible for the children to be served and sit down to eat their food. Last year on average we had approximately two thirds of the student body order food in the cafeteria on a daily basis. We were able to offer a wide variety of items do primarily to the staff of volunteers that gave their time to assist in preparing the daily lunches.

General Volunteer Hours:

The volunteer hours in the cafeteria are from 9:30 AM until 1:15 or 1:30 PM. These volunteers may receive \$10 for their service if they so desire. We are fortunate that many of the volunteers donate their time which helps to keep our operating costs down.

They typically arrive to prepare the main food for the day, whether it is a platter, or a sandwich. Many of the duties include cutting and cleaning of vegetables for the salads or the fruit which we offer on a daily basis. They stock the daily items to be served in the cafeteria line, prepare peanut butter and jelly or bagel and cream cheese sandwiches. When subs, burgers, and other platters are on the menu, they may slice lunch meats, or put the sandwiches together assembly line style. They wash dishes, trays, pans and help to clean up the kitchen after all lunches are served. **No previous experience is required to volunteer. We would be happy to train you.**

Limited Volunteer Hours:

Some volunteers only have a few hours and donate their time first thing in the morning. They clean all the lettuce for salads, slice the fruit and arrange it on the serving trays for the lunch periods. Some can come in at lunch time between 11:00 and 1:15 and serve as a cashier to check the children out as they come through the cafeteria line. We require at least 2 cashiers on a daily basis in order for the children to move through the line in a timely fashion.
